**Terms of Tuition**

1. Students are expected to make a commitment to daily practice of at least 20 minutes in order to make progress.
2. Lessons are for 30 minutes at \$22 per individual lesson. Small group lessons (no more than 4 children) are also available and will be priced dependant on the size of the group. (The most appropriate length lesson will be negotiated prior to signing this contract, dependent on the child's age, experience and goals).
3. Students will not be required to have a drum kit at home and beginning to learn drums does not need to involve an expensive outlay for equipment. I will discuss options for a ear plugs (which will be essential!), a practice pad and drum sticks.
4. Accounts will be sent out at the beginning of each term and are payable within 10 days of receipt.
5. Each term's account will be based on the number of lessons that are planned for that term which may vary from term to term.
6. A lesson timetable is issued at the start of each term. In case of the need to change a lesson time, please contact me directly to make arrangements prior to the lesson day.
7. Please contact me directly before 8.00am on the lesson day if your child is ill or will not be at school for another reason. If possible the lesson may be rescheduled. If not, there will be no refund for missed lessons.
8. A minimum of four weeks notice is required if your child intends to withdraw from lessons.
